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## Suitable products



#### for Storey oiled floors

**WOCA Soap.** This natural product is used for general cleaning of the floor. This soap and oil mixture allows you to maintain your floor while cleaning it. WOCA also offers a pre-mixed spray for spot cleaning. Important: use the correct coloured oil for your product.

**WOCA Wood Cleaner:** This intensive cleaner is used for extremely dirty floors and builders cleans.

**WOCA Oil Refresher:** This product is used regularly for natural oiled floors. You may also use this product to refresh your UV/Hard wax oiled floor, but only after years of wear and tear. **Important**: Use the correct coloured oil for your product.

**WOCA Spot Remover:** Intensive spot remover that dissolves grease, coffee and sugary substances. This product could also remove red wine depending on the time lapse between spilling and cleaning.



# General cleaning instructions



## using WOCA Natural Soap

- 1. Shake Natural Soap carefully before use.
- 2. 125 ml Natural Soap is mixed into 5 litres of lukewarm water. It is recommended always to work with two buckets; one with soap water and one with water for rinsing.
- 3. Clean the floor with minimal water. Leave soapy water on the floor briefly in order to dissolve dirt.
- 4. Remove dirty soap water with hard wrung out mop or cloth and rinse out in rinsing bucket.
- 5. Always wipe the floor with soap water with a hard wrung out mop or cloth in order to re-establish the protective Natural Soap film.

**Important:** Use the correct coloured oil for your product.



# Cleaning of very dirty floors



# using WOCA Wood Cleaner

- 1. 125 ml Wood Cleaner is mixed into 5 litres of lukewarm water. Leave solution on surface to dissolve dirt if necessary.
- 2. Scrub with brush or pad manually or with a floor machine if it is very dirty.
- 3. Wipe clean with mop or cloth. Always wipe a second time to minimise the exposure to water of surface.
- 4. Repeat if floor is extremely dirty.

**Tip:** Always work with two buckets – one with Wood Cleaner mix with water and one with water for rinsing.



## Maintaining your floor



#### with WOCA Oil Refresher

- 1. Shake the bottle well before use.
- 2. The floor must be free from dust before treatment.
- 3. Mix 125ml Oil Refresher into 5 litres of water
- 4. Treat with a light wrung floor cloth or mop lengthwise of the floor.
- 5. Immediately afterwards, dip floor cloth or mob into mixture and wipe the floor with hard wrung floor cloth or mop again lengthwise of the wood. Use two buckets one with Oil Refresher mixed with water and one with rinsing water. It is recommended to clean an area of approx. 10 m2 at any one time. By doing it this way, the floor is exposed to moisture for a short period.
- 6. Leave floor to dry for approximately two hours before use.

# using WOCA Maintainance Paste

- 1. Maintenance Paste application
- 2. Clean the floor with a solution of 1/4 cup Wood Cleaner per gallon of water. Leave the floor to thoroughly dry. The floor must be completely dry before the paste application.
- 3. Buff a thin coat of Maintenance Paste onto 100 s.f. of the floor at a time with white polishing pad.

**Tip:** Due to the risk of self-ignition it is important that sanding dust and oil wetted cloths are soaked in water and disposed of in a tightly closed container after use.

## Suitable products



#### for Storey lacquered floors

**WOCA Vinyl & Lacquer Soap:** Used frequently for the general cleaning of lacquered floors.

**WOCA Wood Cleaner:** This intensive cleaner is used for extremely dirty floors.

**WOCA Vinyl & Lacquer Care:** this product is used once a year to refresh your lacquered floor. This product strengthens and prolongs the life of the surface as it protects against wear, tear and scratches.

**WOCA Intensive Cleaner Spray:** This is a unique ready-to-use-spray for the all-round cleaning of all interior wood work such as furniture, staircases, doors, panels and worktops independently, whether the surfaces are oiled, waxed or lacquered. It provides excellent cleaning, removes the most difficult dirt, grease and Stains, and is fast and easy to apply.

# using the WOCA Vinyl and Lacquer Soap

- 1. Mix 125 ml Vinyl and Lacquer Soap with 5 litres of water for regular cleaning.
- 2. Wash the floor lengthwise. It is recommended to work with two buckets one with solution and one for rinsing. It is recommended to use as little water as possible for the cleaning and make sure that no water is left on the surface after.



# Cleaning of very dirty floors



# using WOCA Wood Cleaner

- 1. 125 ml Wood Cleaner is mixed into 5 litres of lukewarm water. Leave solution on surface to dissolve dirt if necessary.
- 2. Scrub with a brush or pad manually, or with floor machine if it is very dirty. Wipe clean with a mop or cloth. Always wipe a second time to minimise the exposure to water of surface.
- 3. Repeat this if the floor is extremely dirty.

**Tip:** Always work with two buckets – one with Wood Cleaner mixed with water and one with water for rinsing.



## Maintenance your of lacquered floors



#### using WOCA Vinyl & Lacquer Care

- 1. Mix Wood Cleaner with water at a 1:10 ratio.
- 2. Wash the floor thoroughly until the surface is completely clean. The floor must be absolutely dry before application of Vinyl and Lacquer Care.
- 3. Pour the Vinyl and Lacquer Care into a bucket.
- 4. Dip the cloth into the Vinyl and Lacquer Care and wring it thoroughly.
- 5. Apply a thin coat of the Vinyl and Lacquer Care. Continue the application. Do not continue application of Vinyl and Lacquer Care when the floor has started to dry.
- 6. Leave the surface to dry for approximately 30 minutes.

# Targeted cleaning



# using WOCA Intensive Cleaner

- 1. Shake bottle thoroughly.
- 2. Spray the Intensive Cleaner onto the surface
- 3. Leave solution to dissolve affected area.
- 4. Wipe surface dry with a firmly wrung cotton cloth.
- 5. Allow surface to dry.
